NFPA delivers information and knowledge through more than 300 consensus codes and standards, research, training, education, outreach and advocacy; and by partnering with others who share an interest in furthering our mission. Codes and Standards

NFPA is widely known as a codes and standards organization – that's the backbone of what we do, and it always will be. Our mission is to provide you with the information and knowledge you need to do your job well in today's ever-changing environment. Our 300 <u>codes and standards</u> are designed to minimize the risk and effects of fire by establishing criteria for building, processing, design, service, and installation around the world. The more than 250 technical committees, comprised of approximately 9,000 volunteers, review public inputs and vote on the revisions in a process that is accredited by the American National Standards Institute. NFPA provides <u>free online access</u> to its codes and standards.

Public education

As part of NFPA's mission to eliminate death, injury, property and economic loss from fire, electrical and other hazards, NFPA develops easy-to-use educational programs, tools, and resources for all ages and audiences.

- Fire Prevention Week is an annual campaign that addresses a specific fire safety theme.
- <u>Learn Not to Burn®</u> addresses the leading causes of injuries and death among children.
- Remembering When® addresses the leading causes of injuries and death among older adults.
- Sparky the Fire Dog® is the official mascot of NFPA.

Outreach and Advocacy

- Our <u>Fire Sprinkler Initiative</u> encourages the use of home fire sprinklers through increased awareness and adoption of local ordinances or model codes.
- Our <u>Firewise Communities program</u> encourages local solutions for wildfire safety by involving homeowners, community leaders, planners, developers, firefighters, and others in the effort to protect people and property from wildfire risks.

Training

NFPA training includes a variety of convenient ways to access codes and standards training and earn CEUs. Choose from classroom training, online training, on-site training, conferences and certification.

- Our seminars provide insight into the meaning, intent, and proper application of fire and electrical safety codes.
- NFPA administers professional <u>certification programs</u> including Certified Fire Protection Specialist, Certified Fire Inspector, and Certified Fire Plans Examiner.
- The annual <u>NFPA Conference & Expo</u> fosters the exchange of ideas among Association members. New and revised NFPA codes and standards are also discussed and voted upon at these meetings.
- NFPA develops dozens of texts, guides, and other materials that target <u>firefighter and other first responder safety and health</u>.

Research

NFPA is the premier resource for fire data analysis, research, and analysis. This helps guide educational outreach, supports the work of NFPA Technical Committees, and frames the fire-loss picture for organizations, the media, and the general public.

- The <u>Research</u>, <u>Data and Analytics division</u> produces a wide range of annual reports and special studies on all aspects of the nation's fire problem.
- NFPA conducts <u>investigations of fire incidents</u> of technical interest to its constituents, including its Technical Committees and the broader fire community.
- The <u>Fire Protection Research Foundation</u> plans, manages, and communicates research in support of the development of NFPA's codes and standards and educational and public-awareness efforts.
- The <u>Charles S. Morgan Library</u> supports research and maintains the NFPA archives. It is one of the largest fire science libraries in the world
